THE JEAN SCHLIEM SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The HCIA recognizes that education is THE KEY to a well-developed workforce. And no one with HCIA understood that connection better than the first Executive Director, Jean Schliem. It is because of her strong conviction and belief in education, that we name our scholarship in her honor. The Jean Schliem Scholarship Award is given to a student whose parent or guardian works for a member company of HCIA.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The value of the scholarship will be \$1,000.00 per student annually. Two (2) scholarships will be given to candidates attending a traditional two or four year program or a Technical College.

CANDIDATE ELIGIBILITY AND QUALIFICATIONS

In order to be considered for a scholarship, the student must satisfy the following minimum requirements.

- Parent (or legal guardian) is an employee of an HCIA member firm*
- Candidate must have a cumulative high school Grade Point Average (Grades 9-11) of 2.5 or greater based on a 4.0 scale.
- Candidate must have a minimum of 20 ACT score.
- Candidate must have two letters of recommendation - one from an educator and one from an outside source (Not a relative).
- Candidate must have participated in extra curricular activities and provided community service activities OR must have work experience.
- Candidate must have an essay of 400-600 words, typed, double spaced, with references to research sources, if applicable, on individual career goals.
- Completed application must be postmarked by **March 15th, 2012.**
- Scholarship recipients must attend an accredited **Louisiana** two or four year college program.
